A day in the life at Hawkhill Community Centre

We follow the Hawkhill Youth team while they prepare for the days activities!

The afternoon starts with the kitchen staff preparing the snack for the young people and the rest of the team gather the materials for the activity of the day such as homework books, art materials, geek squad box, cooking ingredients or preparing the hall for sports activities, if the weather isn't good enough to go outside.

On Monday we have two youth activities we start at 3:30pm with Homework Club, where we help young people with any homework they may have and also have homework books as well for days where there is no homework. Then we have Art Attack at 5:30pm where the young people can come along and express themselves through as painting, making collages and drawing self-portraits.

On Tuesdays we have Homework Club at 3:30pm and Geek Squad at 5:30pm which is where young people can come and do geeky activities such as magic the gathering, yugioh, Warhammer and dungeons and dragons which is the current popular geek squad activity.

On Wednesdays we have the younger youth club (P1-P7) At 3:30pm where we have activities such as drawing pictures, quizzes, bingo and sports activities such as football, tennis, badminton etc.

On Thursdays we have cooking club from 3:30pm where the young people get to learn how to make things like salads, pizzas, macaroni with a good balance of health eating and treats. Then we have Jog Scotland at 5pm where we exercise in a fun way through games.

On Friday we have the older youth club (P4 and upwards) at 3:30pm where we have activities such as movie night, bingo, art activities, geek squad and sports activities.
